AWARDS

In the first time for a long time there will be several fine awards given to Scouts during the year for good Scouting. Every Scout will have an equal epportunity to win one of these awards. Read the directions below and start planning now to win one of these splendid awards.

Award Number L: A beautiful pair of bronze Boy Scout Bookends will be awarded to the Scout that keeps the best Scout SCRAP' BOOK during the year. The scrap book to contain Scout news clippings, Scout photos, and pictures. Everything pertaining to Scouting that you can pasted in your scrap book will count. The best scrap book will win those bookends.

Award Number 2: An Official Boy Scout Coupass will be swarded the Scout that makes the best nature study collection during the year, and has the test record for the preservation of wild life and domests. The collection can be one of a number of things. Why not shells? insects, flowers, leaves, etc?

A Sterling Silver Boy Scout Ring will be awarded to the Scout that has kept the best record of individual GOOD TURNS for the year. Get a notebook, or diary, and start keeping a record of all your good turns done each day. At the end of the year the Scout that has kept up the best record will win the Boy Scout Ring.

Award Number 4: 100 mile PEDOMETER to the Scout that turns in the twelve best book reports for the year, and who earns the READING Merit Badge. All you have to do is read a book a month which you believe is a good book, write a report on this book, giving your own idea of why the book is good to read, and describing the plot of the book. That is easy, for surely, all of you read books — even more than one a month. Start reading now.

Award Number 5: A weeks stay in camp free to the Scout with the best record in advancement between now and June 1st. Start on your advancement now and earn this free week at camp.
