

Scoutmasters:

Enclosed is a questionnaire. After you have read this bulletin carefully fill out the questionnaire and rush back to me quickly.

The Council is making a drastic summer camping change, and all for the better. Before this summer we have always held what is called a "Mass" camp. Scouts attended as individuals, their meals were cooked for them, they lived in cabins, and instead of receiving a real taste of camping they were only "Play" camping.

This summer we will use entirely the Troop Camping method. The Scouts will cook their own meals by Troops, the programs will be troop planned, and they will enjoy camping more than ever before, and go back home real campers, able to rough it in the open and take care of themselves.

Three different types of Troops will make up the camp life.

- (1) Chartered Troops under own leaderships. This will be the regular Troop membership using its regular troop leadership.
- (2) Chartered Troops with provisional leadership. This is the Troop who's Scoutmaster or Committeemen cannot attend, and the camp will furnish it a leader from its staff.
- (3) Provisional Troop with provisional leadership. Scouts who's troops cannot attend but who wish to go to camp will be placed in a Troop with leadership provided.

COST

It is estimated that chartered Troops, types one and two, can come to Camp at approximately \$3.50 per Scout, broken down as follows:

- (a) \$1.00 per Scout Service Charge and Camp fee. This pays for Staff leadership other than Troop leadership, transportation of perishable foods such as meat, ice, bread, from day to day.
- (b) \$2.50 per Scout for share in Troop expense and food. (Wholesale prices.)

Total cost per Scout \$3.50.

The Scouts placed in Provisional Troops with Provisional leadership will pay a straight fee of \$5.00, which will pay for his food and registration and leadership at Camp.

The thing for you to do is to plan with your Troop which type of Troop camping it will do this summer, make your plans, and let me know. Every Scout a Camper!
