

The Headquarters office of Sunny Land Council, Boy Scouts of America, yesterday announced the results of the recent one-day Scout and Cub clean-up campaign for the Fifth War Loan. The drive, termed "Gleaners after the Reapers" resulted in sales of 264 "E" bonds with a total value of \$26,400.00.

Four prizes, offered to Scouts and Cubs who sold the greatest amount in bonds, were awarded to Scout Teddy Herrmann, Troop 3, Sarasota, for selling \$6,450.00; Scout Joe Burgess, Troop 29, Fort Myers, sales of \$2,900.00; Scout Bobby Berner, Troop 23, Clewiston, \$2,825.00 and Cub Jack Johnston, Pack 4, Punta Gorda, \$1,625.00 bond sales. Duplicate prizes will also be awarded to the Troop and Pack from which these boys come.

Not included in the totals above are sales amounting to over \$2,000, by Troop 28 of Venice-Nokomis. This Troop engaged in a contest with the Girl Scouts of that community, which took place during the regular Bond Drive.
